ONLY ONE GOD – Isaiah 44:6, 8 “Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; ‘I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God... ⁸Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? Ye are even my witnesses. Is there a God beside me? Yea, there is no God; I know not any.’”

Isaiah 43:10 “‘Ye are my witnesses,’ saith the LORD, ‘And my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.’”

BACK DOOR TO THE TRINITY

[Note: The “BACK DOOR TO THE TRINITY” will SHOW Biblical examples of the Trinity in the Bible... The “TRINITY DIAGRAM” EXPLAINS the Biblical reasons for believing in the Trinity.]

The following questions and Biblical answers will show that all three members of the Trinity (Father, Son, and Holy Ghost/Spirit) take credit for the exact same actions or creative acts.

QUESTION #1:

Whose ‘Spirit’ dwells in all believers?

Spirit of God – Romans 8:9a “You are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwells in you...”

Spirit of Christ – Romans 8:9b-10 “...Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.”

Spirit of the Father – Romans 8:11 “But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken [make alive] your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwells in you.”

Holy Ghost – 1 Corinthians 6:19 “What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God.”

QUESTION: How many Spirits dwell in believers?

One Spirit – 1 Corinthians 12:13 “By one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.”

QUESTION #2:
Who raised Jesus from the dead?

The Father – Galatians 1:1 “Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, who raised him from the dead).”

Jesus Raised Himself – John 2:19-21 “Jesus answered and said unto them, ‘Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.’ Then said the Jews, ‘Forty and six years was this temple in building, and will you rear it up in three days?’ But he spoke of the temple of his body.”

The Holy Spirit/Ghost – 1 Peter 3:18 “For Christ also has once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened [made alive] by the Spirit.”

QUESTION: So, did one God or several Gods raise Jesus from the dead?

One God - Acts 2:32 “This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.”

QUESTION #3:
Who created our world?

God– Genesis 1:1 “In the beginning God [In Hebrew – Elohim] created the heaven and the earth.”

The Holy Spirit/Ghost – Genesis 1:2 “And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.”

The LORD – Genesis 2:4 “These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD [In Hebrew – Jehovah] God made the earth and the heavens.”

The Entire Godhead – Genesis 1:26 “And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness.”

The Word/Jesus – John 1:1-3, 14 “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made...¹⁴And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us.”

QUESTION: So, did one God or three Gods create our world?

One God – Isaiah 44:24 “Thus says the LORD, your redeemer, and he that formed you from the womb, ‘I am the LORD that makes all things; that stretches forth the heavens alone; that spreads abroad the earth by myself.’”

QUESTION #4:
Who is the Father of Jesus Christ?

Heavenly Father – John 3:16 “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”

The Holy Ghost/Spirit – Matthew 1:18, 20 “Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost...²⁰The angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a dream, saying, ‘Joseph, thou son of David, fear not
